NRCS REPORT:

Andy Keep gave the NRCS report to the Board. Andy reported on the accomplishments for FY 2018.

Terryberry moved to approve the NRCS report dated September 4, 2018 to include the Conservation Plans as signed for Chase, Dundy and Perkins County. Seconded by Bernhardt.

Roll call vote: 7-yes, 2-absent. Motion carried.

UPPER REPUBLICAN NRD RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Jasper discussed the groundwater quality phase requirement hearing date with the Board. The Board was going to set the hearing date for tonight but there was one well with high nitrates, so Bruce is having a couple other wells checked in that area and would like to see how these results are. Then Bruce can remap the 2018 results. Then possibly the hearing can be set in December or January.

Jasper reviewed the GIS Workshop project. They have been working on the app that will allow the technicians to enter information in the field. The next step is to allow producers to log on and get their usage reports. They are also working on the mail merge for reports.

• Terryberry moved to approve the GIS Workshop Statement of Work for \$14,500. Seconded by Large.

VARIANCE COMMITTEE: No report.

REPORT OF DISTRICT APPLICATIONS, CONTRACTS, AGREEMENTS: None

LEGAL COUNSEL REPORT:

Joel reported that they are working on the resolution related to in-lieu of tax payments to Dundy County and discussed two tracts that are partially exempt and partially taxable. The County Board is supposed to set what portion of that it taxable and what isn't, and that information hasn't been given out yet.

REPUBLICAN RIVER BASIN MEETING/COMPACT REPORT:

Jasper gave a report on the Republican River Compact. Kansas will not be requesting additional water supply from now until spring. They are waiting to see what the water forecast says at the end of the year.

AUGMENTATION PROJECTS:

Bruce has been working with consultants on the drop structure bid to control erosion on the property. Bruce has been working with a contractor on this project and his bid was \$113,876.00. There are issues with steel prices as they keep rising. He is also working on purchasing equipment for sheet piling.

• Bernhardt moved to have Donn Gengenbach approve the contract for \$113,876.00 to include the contingencies. Seconded by Large.

Roll call vote: 7-yes, 2-absent. Motion carried.

ASSISTANT MANAGER'S REPORT:

Nate reported on the telemetry project and that includes 300 radio modules. These will be coming in different shipments this fall. The NRD received another grant on part of them so this will cover about 700 of them.

The NARD Annual Conference was held the last part of September. There were no resolutions presented.
